DOCK OF THE BAY



The harbour pulses as the beating heart of Newquay, a place where generations of maritime history have unfolded and local identity has been forged. Nestled on the edge of the manor of Towan Blystra, this historic waterfront tells a rich story of transformation and resilience.

First documented in the early 15th century as "a keye," Newquay began as a modest fishing hamlet. In 1439, when damage threatened the existing quay, local leaders sought assistance from Edmund Lacy, Bishop of Exeter. The community rallied, with an indulgence granted to those contributing to rebuilding efforts through labour, materials, or financial support.

Richard Carew's Survey of Cornwall in 1603 described the settlement as "newe Kaye," a place primarily suited to fishing. Throughout the early 19th century, the village gradually expanded, with Fore Street connecting Newquay and Towan. By 1882, the Chamber of Commerce officially renamed the growing settlement, marking its evolution from a simple fishing community to a burgeoning tourist destination.

The arrival of the passenger railway in 1876 dramatically transformed Newquay's economic landscape. Traditional harbour-based industries gradually gave way to tourism, yet the waterfront remained resilient. Modern developments have reimagined the harbour, now supporting both local fishing and tourist experiences. Charter boats now offer deep-sea fishing adventures, while local fishing vessels continue to supply fresh



seafood to area restaurants. Whilst fishing trips offer the unique opportunity to catch and cook one's own dinner.

Newquay Sea Safari's invite wildlife enthusiasts to explore the dramatic north coast, discovering hidden coves and encountering marine life including seals, dolphins, and sharks.

Sailing remains a quintessential Newquay experience, with boats setting out between May and September to provide stunning perspectives of the coastline.

A highlight of the waterfront is The Boathouse, a vibrant street food market and bar situated directly on the beach. Here, local traders serve fresh Cornish seafood alongside global culinary offerings. Visitors can enjoy everything

from local delicacies to international cuisine, accompanied by Cornish beverages, cocktails, and artisan coffee.

Newquay's harbour stands as a testament to the town's adaptive spirit—a place where history, culture, and contemporary life merge.




DISCOVERY TRAIL

Unlock the secrets of Newquay's past with the Newquay Discovery Trail Map. Recently revised and reprinted the map has been updated with newly discovered information

enjoyable and informative walks around the town and also a great keepsake of your visit.

The map features the two walks, 'Hetty' and 'Ada' that make up the entire Discovery Trail. The 'Hetty', yellow on the map, takes a mostly coastal route including the beautiful Harbour, the 'House on the Island' and Fistral Beach. The 'Ada', pink on the map, takes in some of the coast but then moves inland passing through the Trenance Leisure Park, Gardens & Boating Lake and near popular Newquay attractions including the Zoo, Newquay Leisure Centre



and the Heron Tennis Centre.

Walking the Newquay Discovery Trails you will find slate discs, about a metre (1yard) in diameter, embedded in the ground at key places of interest. Each slate circle is numbered and these link in with the map with fascinating facts about your location, whilst taking in some spectacular views - a great way to enjoy a tour of Newquay without a car.

The museum's exhibits explore diverse narratives, from the experiences of a local lifeboat coxswain to those of a wartime evacuee. Visitors can engage with an impressive collection of artefacts from the 1900s, listen to recordings of Newquay residents, and even play a beautifully

Trenance Cottages offers a captivating glimpse into Old Newquay, presenting a unique trio of beautifully renovated, Grade II-listed Cornish cottages that stand as the only pre-railway age dwellings open to the public in Cornwall. Nestled within the tranquil and award-winning Trenance Gardens, these historic homes have been meticulously preserved and protected by dedicated volunteers committed to saving a remarkable piece of local heritage.

Located a short walk from the River Gannel and the Rose Garden, the cottages - Vine, Middle, and Rose - provide visitors with an immersive journey through Newquay's rich past. Built on the site of an old malthouse, these dwellings now serve as a fascinating museum that transports guests to a bygone era, offering profound insights into the lives of Comish

restored pianola. The displays not only chronicle individual family histories but also celebrate the town's tourism development and the ongoing work of the Trenance Cottages Newquay charity.

Before departing, visitors can explore the unique gift shop and stop at The Garden tearoom to enjoy a traditional Cornish cream tea. This delightful conclusion provides the perfect opportunity to recharge before continuing to explore the scenic Trenance Valley.



HISTORY OF 2024 1439 NEWQUAY



The Gannel Estuary

Gannel Estuary once almost stole the limelight from the Harbour. In the past, it was dredged to a greater depth allowing larger Schooners and barges that could enter the harbour to be unloaded. Maintenance costs became a burden and now there is little to see of this past history.



The Huer's Hut

One little clifftop dwelling and the Huer's sole aim was to spot shoals of pilchards swimming into Newquay Bay. He would announce their arrival with a bellowing Huer's horn (over 3ft long) whilst calling out Hevva! Hevva! The fishermen on land would race to launch their fishing boats. Once salted and packed, these little fish were in demand for their long 'shelf' life and a mainstay of the Newquay, and Cornish economy for centuries.



Island House

Jago's island. Originally home to just a potato patch and hen house the only access was a now disused steep path. Towan Blystra Manor Estate sold it in 1898. The new owners built a summer house and footbridge by 1905. Sold in 1906 and then used as a seasonal tearoom. Then sold again and the new owner built a permanent dwelling by 1910. Residents have included an inventor and a Lord but it is now holiday accommodation.



TOWAN HEAD

Lifeboats

The sea made Newquay what it is but whilst it may giveth plenty, it can taketh away. Newquay has a long history with the first point of rescue. Developed from privately owned rowboats and pilot gigs of merciful individuals into the RNLI craft launched from Towan Head's Old Lifeboat Station, and now from the Harbour itself.



# Scenic JOURNEYS

Newquay station is conveniently located in the heart of the town, making it a great starting point for scenic rail journeys across Cornwall.

Departing from Newquay, the train crosses Goss Moor and onwards through the beautiful Luxulyan Valley. Get off at Luxulyan station to explore the wooded valley and its mining heritage, or to enjoy a walk to the Eden Project (3 miles).

The Newquay branch line brings you to Par station on the Cornish main line. Change here and head west to visit St Ives, Truro or Falmouth, or east to Looe, Plymouth or on into Devon. Particular highlights include:

## Looe Valley

The branch line to Looe is full of beautiful views out of the train window. The wooded valley teeming with wildlife opens up to glorious estuary views as the river meets the sea. Bird watchers will love this line as, especially at low tide, the river is full of wading birds such as Little Egrets, Grey Herons, Oystercatchers and Curlews. Once in Looe, there's plenty to explore from the harbour to the safe beaches, the excellent restaurants to the maze of narrow streets full of lovely independent shops and pubs.

## St Ives Bay Line

The journey as you arrive into St Ives is one of the most scenic in Britain. The train sweeps along the coast past the golden sands of Hayle Towans and Carbis Bay before arriving at St Ives station, right next to the gorgeous Porthminster Beach, just a few minutes' walk from town. Once you've hit the beach, explore the harbour or wander the shops and art galleries.

## Plymouth
